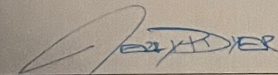

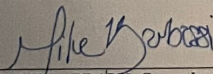

“NATIONAL ENGINEERS WEEK”

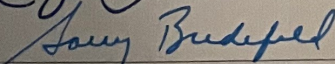
